Construction will be underway in downtown Malone early the summer of 2020 for the expansion of North Franklin Federal Credit Union, being designed and built by PW Campbell and local North Country contractors.

NFFCU announced to their Members last week that they will be starting construction at their current 494 East Main Street location with a 7,500 square foot expansion, in addition to remodeling the current 4,500 square foot structure. Construction of the new building is expected to be completed by early 2021 with the Credit Union remaining open throughout all phases of the project.

“On behalf of the Board of Directors and the NFFCU team, I am excited to announce that we will be expanding and renovating our Downtown Malone location.” Darin Childs, CEO of NFFCU said. “Simply put, we have outgrown our current facility. It is a good problem to have, but it presents some challenges. Today, our talented team has been forced to share close quarters which in turn limits our ability for future growth. Currently, 15 full-time employees work at NFFCU and with the new expansion we will have enough space to accommodate 35+ employees. I believe the expansion will be a symbol of our continued investment and loyalty to our local community and it will also provide the needed space to better serve and support our growing Membership for years to come!

Some of the enhancements include advanced technology, complementary coffee bar, larger lobby and waiting area, community wall, coin machine, multiple ATM’s, an additional entrance from Main Street, and additional parking.
